An authentic African song with an interesting history. It started when pack bearers on safari developed a rhythmic chant to set their walking pace; eventually, the chant became a song, "Flo Me La," which means "To Walk," or "Walking Along." Here, Nina sets the pace-"Flo, fo, flo me la, flo flo fo me la-"-and for the next six minutes and 50 seconds, we are merged with the African wilds, as the pace quickens, slows, and mounts again.


